As a member of the Durham County Youth Council (DCYC) you are an ambassador for the sport and as such, will be asked to maintain a minimum set of behaviours and conduct during your time on the Council.

All individuals on the DCYC will;

- Respect each other and the views and opinions of other DCYC members and be inclusive of all within the Council.
- Maintain a high level of professionalism and wear branded kit when attending meetings and events on DCYC business.
- Reply to communication in a timely manner (i.e. within 5 working days).
- Keep information disclosed by the RFU confidential unless otherwise directed.
- Be an ambassador for rugby, the RFU and promote the core values.
- Not bring the DCYC, RFU or rugby into disrepute with actions that may damage their reputation.
- Complete actions required by deadlines set by the DCYC or RFU colleagues
- Be proactive in sharing new ideas for engaging with young people and increasing participation in rugby.
- Be flexible and well organised with a positive attitude, ensuring help is requested if DCYC commitments cannot be met
- Not make any public statement (whether made as part of a formal interview or not) on any media (including, without limitation, on social media sites) which is defamatory or derogatory in relation to the RFU.
- Not supply any information to the media relating to the RFU without prior approval.
